

Registration

Enrollment is limited to 16 students, 6 refreshers, and 4 auditors. A minimum of 12 students is needed to present the course. Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis and is not complete until payment has been received. The registration fee includes the ATLS student manual 8th edition, continental breakfast, and lunch. You will receive an email confirmation once your registration is received.

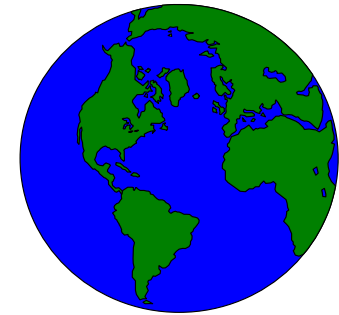

Course Description

The Advanced Trauma Life Support (ATLS)TM Provider Course combines lectures and practical experience to teach participants to establish priorities and stabilize the critically injured patient. During the two day course, students will have the opportunity to practice their assessment techniques and their management of simulated patients in a surgical skill practicum. The ATLS course has been specifically designed for the primary care physician.

The student refresher course is a half-day course offered for physicians who have previously taken the ATLS course. This course must be taken within three months before or six months after the expiration of the physician's ATLS certification. *A copy of the physician's current ATLS student card must accompany registration.*

Mid-level Practitioners

Physician assistants and nurse practitioners may register as either auditors or students. With the 8th edition, mid-levels may receive ATLS certification.

- 1) Demonstrate concepts and principles of patient assessment;
- 2) Establish management priorities in trauma situations;
- 3) Initiate primary and secondary management necessary in the first hour of emergency care for acute life threatening emergencies;
- 4) Demonstrate the skills necessary in initial management of trauma victims, including
 - Initial assessment of victims with multiple injuries
 - Initiation of central line access and shock management
 - Adult /infant intubation
 - Cricothyroidotomy
 - Pleural decompression and chest tube insertion
 - Pericardiocentesis
 - Peritoneal lavage
 - Extremity and spinal immobilization
 - Head trauma management
 - Obstetrical / pediatric trauma
